Error:

God Did Not Mean It That Way. It seems we here this kind of statement all the time in our world today. Well let us consider the origin of such thinking. How can you speak for God in your own opinion? Is this not plagiarism? <u>False reporting of anyone today can put you in trouble with the law. Let me suggest this can cause you to be in trouble with God and his law.</u> He inspired the Bible! How do we get away with saying he did not mean it the way? The Bible can be miss translated. But when the majority of true translators agree it is more likely correct. But most people saying "he did not mean it that way" are not truly experts in translations from Ancient Greek or Hebrew or Aramaic. The safest way to be sure is to compare several translations. You will find they are pretty consistent with each other. These translators have a good reputation of reporting correctly. KJV, NKJV, NASV, ESV, YL, NIV

Most people prefer the King James Version. Why should we trust anyone with an agenda of "This is what they meant?"" Which was strictly their opinion." We better trust God's ability of delivering his word to man. The simplest wording is usually the correct meaning. Remember the scripture speaks of the Simplicity in Christ.

2Co 11:3 But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ.

2Co 1:12 For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward.

Satan's Deception

Genesis 3

²And the woman said to the serpent, "We may eat the fruit of the trees of the garden; ³but of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God has said, 'You shall not eat it, nor shall you touch it, lest you die." ⁴Then the serpent said to the woman, "You will not surely die. ⁵For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil." ⁶So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree desirable

to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate. She also gave to her husband with her, and he ate.

Satan still deceives by this method

Satan using the serpent basically said: God did not mean it that way. You will be ok. God won't hurt you because he is to good. Indulge yourself everything will be ok. Of course, Satan opposes God any way he can and encourages anyone else to do the same. The sentence of death is already on him. He just wants to recruit people to his way for his army. Satan says, doubt God's word everything will be ok. So, some people do just this. They say "look nothing happened so Satan must be correct". They don't understand how God works. God did not punish instantly Adam and Eve with death. They would have never died if they had not sinned. They would have taken of the tree of life and lived forever.

Gen 3:22 Then the LORD God said, "Behold, the man has become like one of Us, to know good and evil. And now, lest he put out his hand and take also of the tree of life, and eat, and live forever"—23 therefore the LORD God sent him out of the garden of Eden to till the ground from which he was taken.

God does punish instantly sometimes but waits other times. The removal from the garden was instant but physical death was later. God has a plain, in place, to save man so he is longsuffering and waits.

Act 17:30 And the times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to repent:

1Pe 3:20 who formerly were disobedient, when once the Divine longsuffering waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was being prepared, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were saved through water.

Satan will try to make us think there is no God. See there is no punishment.

2Pe 2:9 then the Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations and to reserve the unjust under punishment for the day of judgment,

Why does God let Satan deceive in this manner? The answer is freedom to choose. God has always wanted his creation to choose him by choice. If there is no other choice how could we have the freedom of choice.

Eph 3:9 And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ: 10 To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God, 11 According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord: 12 In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the faith of him.

Show me your faith without your works, and I will show you my faith by my works. 19 You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!

1Co 2:9 But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. 10 But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. 11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God. 12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. 13 Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.
