Islem Quran Peaceful?

Islam means "Submission". So, a Muslim is one who submits to Mohamed and the Quran.

There are many peaceful Muslims, but their teaching in the Quran is far from peaceful. Read this passage from the Quran.

Surah 47:4-6, "So, when you clash with the unbelievers, smite their necks until you overpower them, then hold them in bondage. Then either free them graciously or after taking a ransom, until war shall have come to end. If God had pleased, He could have punished them (Himself), but He wills to test some of you through some others. He will not allow the deeds of those who are killed in the cause of God to go to waste. He will show them the way, and better their state, and will admit them into gardens with which he has acquainted them."

Some Muslims believe if you are not a Muslim you are at war with Islam. No wonder some are terrorist. Ask them if they believe this, to test who is peaceful. If they lie, their God will hold them accountable.

Surah 9:73

Make War, O Prophet, against the unbelievers and the hypocrites, and deal with them firmly. Their final abode is Hell: And what a wretched destination!

They teach doing more-good than bad can take them to heaven but the only true way to Heaven is to die in the cause of Allah (Their God). This is why radical terrorists kill. They think it will assure them a place in heaven if they die in their religious cause. Killing is a selfish act not regarding the person who is killed. They are stealing life from the individual. This takes away any chance to be saved to the murdered. God will punish for this if they don't repent and turn from this!

2Pe 3:9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, <u>not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.</u>

Surah 3:157-158, "If you are killed in the cause of God or you die, the forgiveness and mercy of God are better than all that you amass. And if you die or are killed, even so it is to God that you will return."

<u>Surah 3:195</u>, "And those who were deprived of their homes or banished in My cause, and who fought and were killed, I shall blot out their sins and admit them indeed into gardens with rippling streams."

These statements are not peaceful.

I have every respect for everyone's right to choose. God has always given the right to choose. Man choose to sin. God explained the consequences of sin and what the punishment was for sin "Death". This was before the first sin. God did not give

the right to inflict this punishment on anyone. God and is the only one who is authorized to do so or tell anyone else to do so. Also, the Government has been given this right to punish the evildoers who break the law of the land by God.

Government is allowed to punish to evildoers. Because it is God ordained.

Rom 13:1 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God.

2 Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves. 3 For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority? Do what is good, and you will have praise from the same. 4 For he is God's minister to you for good. But if you do evil, be afraid; for he does not bear the sword in vain; for he is God's minister, an avenger to execute wrath on him who practices evil. 5 Therefore you must be subject, not only because of wrath but also for conscience' sake.

The exception is when the government goes contrary to God's commands.

Act 5:26 Then the captain went with the officers and brought them without violence, for they feared the people, lest they should be stoned. 27 And when they had brought them, they set them before the council. And the high priest asked them, 28 saying, "Did we not strictly command you not to teach in this name? And look, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this Man's blood on us!" 29 But Peter and the other apostles answered and said: "We ought to obey God rather than men.

When God used sinful people, to inflict punishment on the Jews, for their sins. He always punished those doing the punishment after a time for their sins they committed while doing this punishment.

Muslims are called radical if they following their belief. It is obvious they are using their idea of the several passages in the Quran. They consider everybody that is not a Muslim deserves death. (They don't understand this is incorrect.) They would need to destroy most of the world to accomplish this. There would be no prosperity for anyone in this even them. They believe they are doing what the Quran teaches. They are killing each other because of differences in interpretation of the Quran. These beliefs will only cause the complete destruction of planet earth. They don't realize they are destroying their own religion. Fortunately, there are Muslims who don't think that way.

A kingdom divided cannot stand!

Mat 12:25 But Jesus knew their thoughts, and said to them: <u>"Every kingdom divided</u> against itself is brought to desolation, and every city or house divided against itself will not stand.

Unfortunately, the Quran does not accept the divinity of Jesus. This makes this teaching "Anti-Christ". They believe Jesus was only a prophet. In other words, they believe in Jesus but not in a Christ. The Christ is the savior. The Quran does

not speak of a Christ or a Savior. The Quran says Mohamed was only a prophet. It does not teach of a Savior.

Surah 4: 171 b

So, believe in God and His apostles, and do not call Him 'Trinity.' Abstain from this for your good; for God is only one God, and far from His glory is it to beget a son. All That is in the heavens and the earth belongs to Him; and sufficient is God for all help.

Water is still water even when goes to different states (liquid, solid, gas). You are deigning the power of God to exist in different states ("The Trinity" Father, Son, and The Holy Spirit") <u>Water is still water!</u> <u>God is still God.</u> Remember God is a spirit. He is not of flesh.

The entire Christian Bible is based on the divinity of Jesus Christ. To accept their Book, you would have to reject the Bible. Faithful Christians will not do this. I won't do this.

Any group that uses murder or torture in attempts to convert people to their religion are not showing the love God. Which God's love has always been shown to man! God choose preaching to convert people to God.

1Co 1:21 For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, it <u>pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe.</u>

The Christian Bible does not teach to get revenge. It teaches to love your enemies.

Mat 5:44 But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you, 45 that you may be sons of your Father in heaven; for He makes His sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust.

Rom 12:14 Bless them which persecute you: bless, and curse not. 15 Rejoice with them that do rejoice, and weep with them that weep. 16 Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits. 17 Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men. 18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men. 19 Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord. 20 Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head. 21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.

If any person really loved God, they would teach not to kill or torturer.

Force does not convert anyone. Only reasoning and compassion convert. Force only causes one to lie for survival.

I have heard it said that if you try to convert a Muslim to Christianity, this considered persecution by some of them. If this is so, a Christian can claim they are being persecuted if a Muslim tries to convert a Christian to Islem. How can anyone teach anyone anything if this is practiced? How is conversion accomplished if no one listens to the other? Threats accomplish nothing. Torture only brainwashes. Every other religion in the world converts by teaching. Any religion that wants to destroy every other religion by force is not teaching, but helping Satan by condemning souls. Christians should never use force to convert neither should anyone else. Remember not everyone who claims "Christianity" is really a Christian! Only those who obey him are Christians!

Heb 5:8 Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; 9 And being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;

An error seemly taught in the following seems to teach that Christianity teaches Marry was part of the trinity of God. This a mistake the Bible does not teach this. If anyone reads the bible, they could see this. Therefore, how many other mistakes are made? The trinity is the Father, Son and the Holy Ghost.

Surah 5: 116

And when God will ask: "O Jesus, son of Mary, did you say to mankind: 'Worship me and my mother as two deities apart from God?'" (Jesus) will answer: "Halleluja. Could I say what I knew I had no right (to say)?...You know what is in my heart though I know not what You have..."

1Co 8:6 But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.

Mat 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. 19 Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: 20 Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you alway, even unto the end of the world. Amen.

The Father Son and the Holy Ghost are one.

Joh 17:19 And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth. 20 Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; 21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. 22 And the glory which thou

God wants us to be part of God in unity. God is a spirit. He is not of flesh. He is not born physically as we are, neither was Jesus until the immaculate birth. He was alive before his physical birth. Thus, the Father, the Son and The Holy Ghost are all together one each doing God's will. God is infinite and always has been and always will be.

Joh 8:54 Jesus answered, If I honour myself, my honour is nothing: it is my Father that honoureth me; of whom ye say, that he is your God: 55 Yet ye have not known him; but I know him: and if I should say, I know him not, I shall be a liar like unto you: but I know him, and keep his saying. 56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad. 57 Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham? 58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.

Joh 4:23 But the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. 24 God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in truth.

Joh 10:30 <u>I and my Father are one.</u>

Joh 14:10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. 11 Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake. 12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. 13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. 14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. 15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.

and in the Hereafter their doom shall be dreadful. <u>34</u> But those who repent before they are subdued should know that God is forgiving and kind.

Surah 2:191

And fight those (who fight you) wheresoever you find them, and expel them from the place they had turned you out from. Oppression is worse than killing. Do not fight them by the Holy Mosque unless they fight you there. If they do, then slay them: Such is the requital for unbelievers

Surah 9:5

But when these months, prohibited (for fighting), are over, slay the idolaters wheresoever you find them, and take them captive or besiege them, and lie in wait for them at every likely place. But if they repent and fulfill their devotional obligations and pay the zakat, then let them go their way, for God is forgiving and kind.

Surah 2:216

Enjoined on you is fighting, and this you abhor. You may dislike a thing yet it may be good for you; or a thing may haply please you but may be bad for you. Only God has knowledge and you do not know.

The people of the Book are Christians spoken of below.

Surah 9:29

Fight those people of the Book who do not believe in God and the Last Day, who do not prohibit what God and His Apostle have forbidden, nor accept divine law, until all of them pay protective tax in submission.

Surah 9:73

Make War, O Prophet, against the unbelievers and the hypocrites, and deal with them firmly. Their final abode is Hell: And what a wretched destination!
